Dear Food Establishment:

The following documents are needed to obtain a food service permit in the Town of Wrentham:

- 1. <u>Application for Food Service Establishment</u>: This application must be completed in its entirety, do not leave any sections blank. Please note that the emergency contact number should not be the phone number of the location but rather someone who can be reached in an emergency after hours. Please note that you must attach a current copy of your menu with your application.
- 2. <u>Workers' Compensation Insurance Affidavit</u>. Massachusetts General Law Chapter 152 requires all businesses submit a Workers' Compensation Affidavit. The Workers' Compensation Affidavit can be found on our website.
- 3. <u>Certificate of Liability:</u> You must furnish the Certificate of Liability. The certificate must be dated within two weeks of the application and list the Town of Wrentham as a Certificate Holder.
- 3. <u>Good Standing Approval</u>: If you (owner) or the organization owns property in the Town of Wrentham, you must have this form processed by the Town Treasurer's office. Please provide a fully-executed Good Standing Approval form with your application. This form can be found on our website.
- 4. <u>Food Certifications:</u> Massachusetts State Law requires the following certifications in order to obtain a permit:
- a) All food service establishments must have one person certified in food protection. Please provide current copies of this certification with your application.
- b) All food service establishments must have one person *per shift* certified in choke safety. Please provide current copes of this certification with your application.
- c) All food service establishments must have one certified food protection manager with an allergen awareness certificate. Please see the state website for information on how to obtain this training. http://www.mass.gov/eohhs/docs/dph/environmental/foodsafety/allergen-awareness-vendors.pdf

Applications will not be accepted without any of the above documents and certifications.

Fee Schedule: Under 50 seats \$165, 51-100 seats \$220, 101+ seats \$275

All checks should be made payable to the Town of Wrentham/Board of Health. The Town of Wrentham cannot process credit or debit cards. The Board of Health office hours are Monday 8am to 2pm, Tuesday 12pm to 7pm, Wednesday 8am to 1pm and Thursday 11am to 4pm.
